CRUNCH CORNER

Takeaway Foods Can Add Up

Have you noticed some fast food restaurants now display the number of kilojoules in their meals and drinks? New regulations in New South Wales require larger food chains to exhibit the average number of kilojoules next to the foods and beverages listed on their menu boards. These chain food outlets must also display the average kilojoule (kJ) intake for an adult, which is 8700kJ per day.

You may need fewer or more kilojoules each day to maintain a healthy weight. If you're interested to find the right number of kilojoules for you and your children, go to www.8700.com.au. Here you will find:

- a handy tool that calculates how many kilojoules are right for you and your children. Simply go to the 'kJ Explained' tab and then 'Your Ideal Figure'.
- a search tool that allows you to check the kilojoule content of over 3000 fast foods, before you head out.
- a free '8700kJ mobile app' to download and help you make informed food choices when eating out.
- practical tips and tools to help you and your children achieve the right balance between the kilojoules you consume and the kilojoules you burn.
